SCHEDULED TRAILS - Arrive 15 minutes before start time

Level 1 - R70 / R60 u12yrs: Lead-rein walk around the exercise ring for the first time rider. Available daily between 08h15 and 10h15

Level 2 - R210 / R190 u12yrs: 30 minute walk trail for anyone who has never ridden out on a trail. Children u12yrs need to be accompanied by an adult on foot; this also applies to riders who do not understand English well enough to follow instructions and the accompanying person who is walking with them on foot must be fluent in English in order to relay the guide's instructions. Every morning @ **09h15** for 09h30

Level 3 - R350 / R310 u12yrs: One hour walk trail for novice riders. Children u12yrs need to be accompanied by an adult on foot; this also applies to people who do not understand English well enough to follow instructions and the accompanying person who is walking with them on foot must be fluent in English in order to relay the guide's instructions. Daily @ **08h00** for 08h15, **10h30** for 10h45 and **13h45** for 14h00

Level 4 - R350: An hour trail ridden at a walk and trot; for riders who only ride occasionally, have trotted before and are able to control the horse's direction and following distance. Minimum age 12yrs and riders need to understand English well enough to follow instructions.

Daily @ **08h00** for 08h15, **10h30** for 10h45 and **13h45** for 14h00

Level 5 - R350 One hour trail for skilled riders only. Minimum age 14yrs and riders need to understand English well enough to follow instructions Daily @ **08h00** for 08h15, **10h30** for 10h45 and **13h45** for 14h00

Level 6 - R670 Two hour trail for skilled riders who are riding fit. Minimum age 14yrs and riders need to understand English well enough to follow instructions. Times on enquiry
