### **SCHEDULED TRAILS - Arrive 15 min. before start time**

**Level 1: 08h30 to 10h15 R50:** Lead rein ride around the exercise ring for young children, to get them acquainted with horses and ready to try the next Level up or for the very nervous first time riders who do not know how they will react when on a horse.

**Level 2: 09h15 for 09h30 R155:** 30 minute walk trail around the Restaurant dam for young children or nervous older riders. Children under 12 years or non English, isiZulu or Afrikaans speaking riders to be accompanied by an adult on foot.

**Level 3: 08h00 for 08h15 / 10h30 for 10h45 / 13h45 for 14h00 R260:** One hour walk trail for novice riders. Nervous 1<sup>st</sup> time riders to book the Level 2 trail. Children under 12 years or non English, isiZulu or Afrikaans speaking riders to be accompanied by an adult on foot.

**Level 4: 08h00 for 08h15 / 10h30 for 10h45 / 13h45 for 14h00 R260:** One hour trail ridden at a walk and trot; riders must feel confident on a horse, trotted before and able to properly control the horse's direction and following distance. Minimum age 12 years.

**Level 5: 08h00 for 08h15 / 10h30 for 10h45 / 13h45 for 14h00 R260:** One hour trail for skilled riders only. Minimum age 14 years.

**Level 6:** time on application R499: Two hour ride for skilled riders who are riding fit. Minimum age 14 years.
